GENERAL INFORMATION

SAFETY AND SECURITY

- ❖ In case of an emergency, *dial 911.
 - * If dialing from a landline on base, the call automatically would be forwarded to first responders on base. If you dial 911 with your cell phone the call would automatically would be forwarded to the San Angelo first responders, please mention you are on base.
- ❖ Please familiarize yourself with all fire exits and fire extinguishers.
- ❖ Propane BBQ grills are conveniently located for guest use. Be considerate of others, turn-off the gas valve, clean/pick up after use and please do not use charcoal.
- ❖ Do not place grills within 20 feet of the building or underneath trees as this may inadvertently cause a fire.
- ❖ Do not store flammable liquids (gasoline, lighter fluid, propane, paint, etc.) in your room.
- ❖ Only use cooking or heating devices provided in your room.
- ❖ Please make sure all hot appliances such as irons, coffee pots, hot wax and oiler warmers etc. are turned off and unplugged after use.
- ❖ Open flame devices, candles and hot plates are prohibited.
- ❖ Secure your room before you leave. Please do not leave the door open.
- ❖ Secure your room keys/key cards. Please report any lost keys immediately to the Front Desk. Our staff is not permitted to use their keys to let guests back into their rooms without proper identification.
- ❖ Keep all valuables out of sight or locked up at all times. There is a safe provided in your room for your convenience.
- ❖ When utilizing the laundry facility, please do not leave clothes unattended in the washers and dryers for a long period of time. Lodging is not responsible to lost or stolen clothes.

BOMB THREAT

- ❖ If you receive a bomb threat, ask the individual where the bomb is located and the time it will go off.
 - ❖ DO NOT HANG UP THE PHONE. The phone company will trace the call even after the caller hangs up.
 - ❖ Use another phone to call 911 and notify them of the threat (time and target). Be sure to give them your name, location, and telephone number.
 - ❖ Notify all occupants of the targeted building to evacuate immediately.
 - ❖ Evacuate a minimum of 500 feet from the building.
 - ❖ Use AF Form 440, *Bomb Threat Aid* and GAFBVA 31-2, *Bomb Threat Evacuation Guide* located in the front of this Book to assist in providing as much information as possible to 17 Security Forces Squadron.

FORCE PROTECTION CONDITIONS

- ❖ FORCE PROTECTION CONDITION ALPHA – Declared as a general warning of possible terrorist activity, and when circumstances do not justify full implementation of a higher force protection condition. This may be declared when incidents occur which could lead to possible terrorist incidents worldwide.

- ❖ FORCE PROTECTION CONDITION BRAVO – Declared when there is an increase and more predictable threat of terrorist activity, even though no particular target has been identified. This will be declared if information exists that terrorist elements are actively preparing for operations in the area of Texas, or when SRO1, Increased Vigilance Posture, is implemented.

- ❖ FORCE PROTECTION CONDITION CHARLIE – Declared when an INCIDENT occurs or when intelligence is received that some form of terrorist action is imminent and DOD or US targeting is present. This will be implemented when SRO2, Advanced Readiness Posture, is implemented.

- ❖ FORCE PROTECTION CONDITION DELTA – Declared when a condition exists in the immediate area where a terrorist attack HAS OCCURRED or when intelligence is received that terrorist action against Goodfellow AFB resources is likely.

SEVERE WEATHER AWARENESS

- ❖ THUNDERSTORM WATCH – Heavy thunderstorm activity has been sighted. Prepare to take shelter.

- ❖ THUNDERSTORM WARNING – Rain, storm winds, and possible hail. Seek Shelter.

- ❖ TORNADO WATCH – Weather conditions are favorable for the development of tornadoes.

- ❖ TORNADO WARNING – Tornado has been sighted. Take shelter.

TAKE THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS

- ❖ Stay informed. Monitor the local radio or television station for the latest weather advisory.

 - ❖ If you are in the watch area, **be prepared to take shelter**. For protection against tornadoes, you should select a central hallway area or centrally located room on the lowest floor of your duty section or quarters away from windows, doorways and wide ceilings.

 - ❖ Preposition sturdy tables, blankets, flashlights, etc. in the area selected for use during tornadoes.

 - ❖ Unless a tornado warning is issued, you should not further interrupt your normal routine, except remain alert for the approach of threatening weather conditions or the termination of the

TAKE THE FOLLOWING ACTIONS (CONT.)

Tornado watch.

ALERT SIGNALS

- ❖ 3-5 Minute Steady Tone - Alert Signal. Imminent peacetime emergencies only.
- ❖ 3-5 Minute Wavering Tone - Attack Warning. Actual attack is imminent or in progress. Take immediate shelter or other protective actions.
- ❖ 30 Second duration wavering or steady tone - Test Signal. Testing of alert signal only. Take no action.

SEVERE WEATHER SAFETY RULES

- ❖ Pay attention to weather watches and warnings issued by the National Weather Service.
- ❖ Become familiar with the counties and major cities in your area.
- ❖ Check the weather forecast before leaving home for extended periods of time.
- ❖ Stay tuned to a weather station on the radio.
- ❖ Seek shelter IMMEDIATELY if threatening weather occurs.

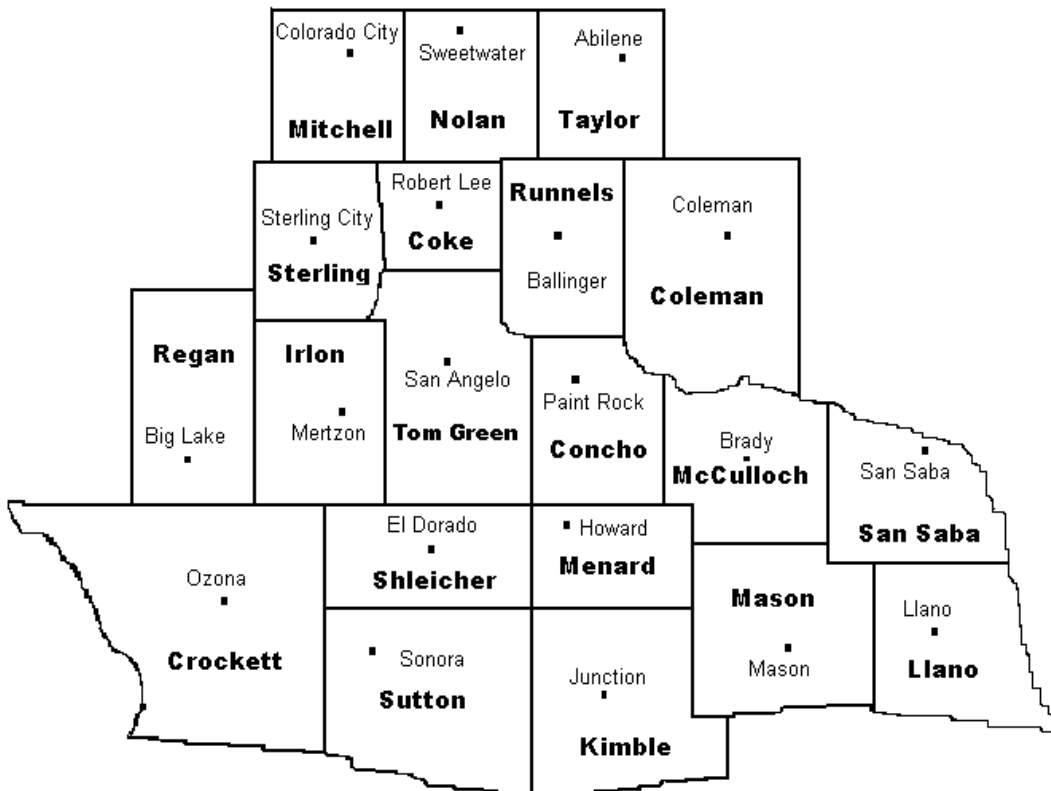
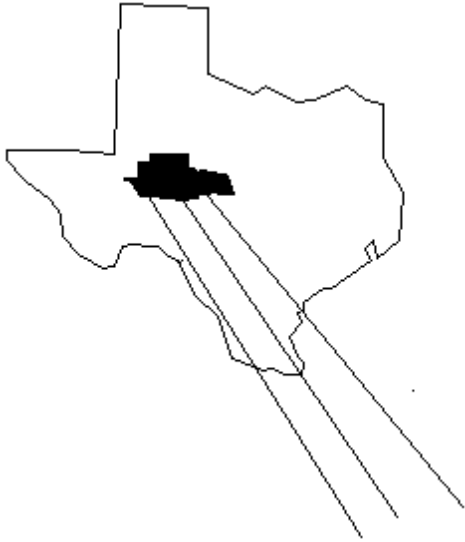

GUEST RESPONSIBILITIES

- ❖ **Check-out time is 1100.** A late check-out fee will apply after 1100. **A late check-out fee is one night's room charge.** Late checkouts are only granted based upon availability.
 - ❖ We are required to process payment every 15 days. You may give us authorization to bill your credit card automatically or stop by either of our front desks to pay in person. Please inquire at the front desk for more information regarding billing.
 - ❖ We want to ensure our housekeeping staff provides the best service possible; however, we are unable to move guests' personal belongings from where the guest has placed them. BUSINESS CENTER

For your convenience, we have a business center located on the second bldg. 3305. It's open 24/7.

BUSINESS SUITE PAYMENTS

For our Distinguished Visitors, the Angelo Inn has provided a quick method of payment by placing an express checkout envelope in your room. Distinguished Visitors may pay their sundry, room, and telephone charges prior by using the payment envelopes provided in the room. Payments can be made via personal check, cash or credit card provided we have the credit card number on file (VISA or MC only). This will enable you to leave your key in the room and depart without having to make another trip to the front desk.

BUSINESS SUITE SUNDRIES

CLASSIFIED STORAGE (Overnight Repository)

Goodfellow AFB Command Post is an overnight repository for classified storage. Command Post is located at 351 Kearney Blvd. Bldg. 430. You may call them by dialing (325) 654-3558.

COFFEE MAKER INSTRUCTIONS

CV1 Machine (Single cup coffee maker)

- ❖ Insert disposable brew basket and coffee filter packet into the coffee maker. (Do not remove the coffee from the filter paper.)
- ❖ Fill coffee cup with cold water.
- ❖ Pour water into reservoir.
- ❖ Place coffee cup under brew basket.
- ❖ Press and release start button.
- ❖ Light will turn off once the brewing process is complete.

Keurig Machine

- ❖ Press the large PRESS TO OPEN button on top of the brewer.
 - ❖ Lift the Brewer Handle, insert a K-Cup. (Do not puncture or remove foil lid)
 - ❖ Lower the handle completely and firmly to close.
 - ❖ The hot water tank will open automatically.
 - ❖ Fill the hot water tank with tap water or bottled water up to the fill line indicator.
 - ❖ Close the hot water tank cover.
 - ❖ The **PLACE CUP** light will be flashing.
 - ❖ Place a 10oz coffee cup in the dispense area on the drip tray. Press the flashing BREW button.
 - ❖ The **HEATING** light will be illuminated. When the water reaches temperature, the **HEATING** light will turn off and the coffee will start to dispense in less than 3 minutes.

COPIER/FAX SERVICE

Lodging offers complimentary copier and fax service upon request. It's located in bldg. 3305. It's open 24/7. Dial "0" from your room phone should you require any assistance or information.

"DO NOT DISTURB SIGN"

The "Do Not Disturb" sign may not be displayed for more than two consecutive days. Housekeeping is required to enter and service the room on the third day. If you would like your room serviced daily, please make sure the sign is removed by 1400. Pet-Friendly TLF units are required to be serviced daily. Please make sure the sign is removed by 1100 to ensure the housekeeping staff has enough time to service the unit. All pets must be kenneled while the housekeeping staff is servicing your unit.

ENERGY CONSERVATION

Conserve energy by turning off the television and lights when room is not being occupied. Lodging rooms are equipped with energy efficient light bulbs. When turned on, the light bulbs will appear dull until they have warmed up. Please allow a few minutes for this process.

FAX SERVICES

Free internet access, printing, copying, and DSN fax services are available at the Front Desk. Please contact the Front Desk for additional information.

FIREARMS

FRONT DESK

Angelo Inn front desk is located in bldg. 3305. It's open 24/7. We also offer complimentary coffee, hot chocolate, and tea in both lobbies. Dial "0" from your room phone should you require any assistance or information.

HOUSEKEEPING SERVICES

The Housekeeping department strives to make your stay a pleasant experience by providing you a clean and sanitized room at check-in. For the safety of our housekeepers and to better assist you, please make sure that floor and bed is cleared. The Housekeeping staff is trained not to touch or move guests' personal belongings. Please utilize closets, drawers, and the safe to store

personal belongings. The Housekeeping staff will not service the room while guests are in it.

LIGHT SERVICE

- ❖ Amenities restocked: coffee and coffee supplies.
- ❖ Areas cleaned: bathroom to include the tub/shower, carpets, counter tops, floors, mirrors, sink, toilets and vanities.
- ❖ Bed will be made if there are no personal belongings left on top of the bed.
- ❖ Light dusting of furniture.
- ❖ Towels will be replaced if left on the floor.
- ❖ Wastebaskets emptied and cleaned.

FULL SERVICE (8th DAY)

(To include light service duties as listed above):

- ❖ Bed linen will be replaced.
- ❖ Furniture will be polished.
- ❖ More thorough cleaning of the shower door/curtains.

CHECK-OUT

- ❖ All beds are made with freshly cleaned mattress pad, sheets, pillow covers, pillow cases, blanket, and bedspread.
- ❖ All personal/coffee amenities and towels are replaced.
- ❖ All areas are cleaned to include ceilings, ceiling fans, baseboards, light fixtures, walls, windows/sills, sofa cushions, and vents.
- ❖ Entire bathroom is cleaned and sanitized.
- ❖ Entire kitchen to include all appliances, dishware, and utensils are cleaned and sanitized.
- ❖ Overall high and low dusting and furniture polished.
- ❖ The carpet will be vacuumed to include under and behind the furniture.
- ❖ The floors are swept, mopped, and sanitized.
- ❖ Wastebaskets are emptied, cleaned, and sanitized.

MAINTENANCE

Lodging and 17th Civil Engineer Squadron (CES) strive to maintain high standards of maintenance in all of our guest rooms. Should you experience any problems with the plumbing, HVAC or equipment, please report it promptly. You may call either the front desk by dialing '0' or maintenance department by dialing '2009'. You may also fill out a maintenance form in the front cover of the guest directory. *Please do not leave the "Do Not Disturb" sign on your door.* Lodging and 17 CES personnel are not authorized to enter your room when it is displayed.

MESSAGE SERVICE

Emergency messages will be delivered to your room by lodging or security personnel. Routine messages can be taken through our voicemail system. To check voice mail, please dial 6000 and follow voice prompts.

NOISE/QUIET HOURS

Personnel who reside in lodging attend courses and other activities which require them to work various shifts. Lodging is designated as a 24/7 quiet area. Noise, including radio and television volume, should be kept to a minimum, to allow shift workers to get the required rest.

PESTS

The control of pests, primarily the roach, which is known in this part of the country as the 'Texas Water Bug', is an on-going problem. These creatures, along with field mice, small harmless lizards, spiders and numerous flying insects love the climatic condition in this area. Please help us by properly storing all food items and allowing our housekeeping staff to take trash out daily. If you see any of these pests, please dial '0' or '2009' from your room phone to report it or fill out a maintenance form in the front cover of this book. Prompt attention by 17 CES and our staff will help keep it under control.

RESERVATIONS

Should you require further reservations at the Angelo Inn, please contact our Front Desk staff by dialing "0" from your room phone or (325) 654-3686. We can also assist you with reservations for commercial off base hotels.

RV STORAGE (and other large vehicles)

Owners should contact equipment rental to procure parking for their RVs or other large vehicles. You may reach them by dialing (325) 654-5643. They are located in bldg. 109.

SAFE INSTRUCTIONS

- ❖ Upon first using the safe, turn the black reset switch located on the inside of the door next to the hinge to the ON position.
Locking the safe with a code:
- ❖ Enter any 4-digit code into the safe keypad and press the "#" button.
- ❖ The safe's display will read "CLOSE" and the safe will lock.
- ❖ To open, enter the same code.
- ❖ The safe's display will read "OPEN" and the safe will unlock.
- ❖ The safe's memory will clear and the user may now lock the safe with a different code.

SHEET CHANGES

Housekeeping changes sheets at every checkout and once every 8 days for long term guests. Generally, sheet changes are due the same day of the week as check-in. Please allow our housekeepers the opportunity to replace your linen by not placing the 'Do Not Disturb' sign on the door on that day.

SUNDRY STORE

Hungry or need a drink to quench your thirst? Our Sundry Shop is located in the lobby of bldg. 3305. We offer a variety of non-alcoholic and alcoholic beverages, chips, candy, and personal hygiene products.

VENDING MACHINES

- ❖ Building 711 has one vending machine located on the first floor near the laundry facility.

GOODFELLOW AFB HISTORY

Home to the 17th Training Wing, Goodfellow Air Force Base is a United States Air Force training installation subordinate to Air Education & Training Command. Goodfellow's chief mission is to develop and deliver firefighter and intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance (ISR) training for Air Force, Army, Navy, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard personnel plus students from partner nations and numerous national agencies.



Additionally, the base provides special instruments training in support of the US Atomic Energy Detection System. Located on 1,235 acres near the west Texas city of San Angelo, Goodfellow boasts a population of about 5,000, more than one-half of whom are students.

Goodfellow's history traces to the period prior to Pearl Harbor when President Franklin Delano Roosevelt, responding to the train of aggression across Europe, Africa and Asia, began a program of preparedness that included the construction of facilities dedicated to advanced air training. Several such bases were envisioned for Texas and one, specifically, for the Fort Worth-Midland-San Angelo triangle. Civic leaders from San Angelo immediately commended their community to the War Department. A generous offer of sewage and electrical service, a railroad spur, and a 50-year lease on 640 acres at one dollar per year easily decided the issue.

Construction of the new flying training school began at once. Officially established on 17 August 1940, the airfield was ready for occupancy by January 1941 and the first students arrived in February. On 11 June 1941 the post was officially renamed Goodfellow Field.

The next four years witnessed the graduation of more than 10,000 pilots and the decoration of scores of these for outstanding heroism in action against Germany, Italy, and Japan. Goodfellow continued to train pilots into the post war, first on the T-6 *Texan* and the T-28 *Trojan* and then, beginning in 1954, on the twin-engine B-25 *Mitchell*. On 3 September 1958, with nearly 20,000 aviators to its credit, Goodfellow graduated its last class of pilots.

The end of flying training at Goodfellow marked the transfer of the base from Air Training Command to the USAF Security Service and the beginning of a new mission – the training of

Force personnel in the advanced cryptologic skills that the Security Service required at installations worldwide. Eight years later, in 1966, the mission expanded further to include joint-service training in these same skills for Army, Navy and, in the following decade, Marine Corps personnel.

Reverting to Air Training Command in 1978, the base emerged from a brush with closure to become a Technical Training Center in 1985 and the site for the consolidation of all Air Force-managed intelligence training. During the next three years, Goodfellow received advanced imagery training from Offutt AFB, Nebraska; electronic intelligence operations training from Keesler AFB, Mississippi; and targeting, intelligence applications, and general intelligence training from Lowry AFB, Colorado.

On 1 July 1993, the 17th Training Wing was activated at Goodfellow. With the change in name came a marked diversification and increase in mission as the base realignment and closure process brought special instruments training and fire protection training to the base. During the next two decades the wing produced firefighters and intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance (ISR) professionals in ever increasing numbers, more than doubling the production of graduates. Over the same period, the wing rebuilt the base, replacing much of the original World War II construction and making this very old base one of the most modern in the Air Force.
